Headset Key with To		Toggles the headset mode on or off. The LED indicator glows green when the headset mode is activated.

	Hold Key	Places a call on hold or resumes a held call.

### **Calling & Programming**

#### **BASIC CALL HANDLING**

#### MAKING A CALL

- 1. Lift the handset or press the speaker/headset key for handsfree.
- 2. At the dial tone, enter the number you wish to call, or select the desired line key, or select a contact from phonebook.
- 3. Press **Call** soft key.

#### ENDING A CALL

Place the handset on its cradle or press the **End Call** softkey or **Cancel** key.

#### **REDIALING A NUMBER**

To access the outgoing calls list in the call history, press the **Redial** key once and press **Call.** To redial the most recently dialed number, press the **Redial** key twice.

#### ANSWERING THE INCOMING CALL

- 1. Lift the handset for handset operation.
- 2. For speakerphone operation, press the **Speaker** or **Headset** key.
- 3. Press Answer soft key.

#### HOLDING A CALL

To place a call on hold when on an active call:

- For T54W users, press the **Hold** key, or **Hold** soft key.
- For T41S users, press Hold soft key.

#### **RESUMING A CALL**

To resume a held call:

- For T54W users, press the **Hold** key again, or **Resume** soft key.
- For T41S users, press Resume soft key.

#### MUTING THE MICROPHONE

Press the **Mute** key to mute the microphone on the handset, headset, or speakerphone.

#### TRANSFERRING A CALL

To transfer a call:

- For T54W users,
  - 1. Press the **Transfer** key or **Transfer** soft key.

- 2. Enter or select the desired number.
- Press the Transfer key or B Transfer soft key to complete a blind transfer. Or press Call to contact the 3<sup>rd</sup> party, after the contact answers the call, press the Transfer key, or Transfer soft key to complete an attended transfer.
- For T41S users,
  - 1. Press the **Tran** soft key.
  - 2. Enter the desired number to transfer.
  - 3. Press the **Tran** soft key again to complete a blind transfer. Or, after the contact answers the call, press the **Tran** soft key again to complete an attended transfer.

#### CONFERENCE CALL

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To create a conference call when on an active call:

- For T54W users,
  - 1. Press the **Conference** soft key.
  - 2. Dial the 3<sup>rd</sup> party.
  - When the 3<sup>rd</sup> party answers the call, press the **Conference** soft key again to create a conference.
- For T41S users,
  - 1. Press the **Conf** soft key.
  - 2. Dial the 3<sup>rd</sup> party.
  - When the 3<sup>rd</sup> party answers the call, press the Conf soft key again to create a conference.

#### FORWARDING A CALL

- 1. Navigate to Menu->Features->Call Forward.
- Select the desired forwarding type (Always, Busy, No Answer) and select Enabled from the corresponding field.
- Enter the destination number you want to forward incoming calls to in the Forward to field.

#### DISABLE CALL FORWARDING

- 1. Navigate to Menu->Features->Call Forward.
- 2. Select the desired forwarding type and select **Disabled** from the corresponding field.
- 3. Select Save.

#### **ADVANCED FEATURES**

#### SETUP SPEED DIAL

- 3. Navigate to Menu->Features->Dsskey.
- 4. Select the desired line key and then press the **Enter** soft key.
- 5. Select **SpeedDial** from the **Type** field.
- 6. Enter the name in the **Label** field and phone number or extension number in the **Value** field.
- 7. Press Save.

\*\*You can also long press the line key to configure it.

#### SETUP LINE KEY WITH OTHER FEATURES

- 1. Navigate to **Menu->Features->Dsskey**.
- Select the desired line key (except the reserved 1<sup>st</sup> line key), and then press the Enter soft key.
- 3. Select the desired features from the **Type** field.
- 4. Enter the corresponding information in the **Label** field and **Value** field if applicable.
- 5. Press Save.

\*\*You can also long press the line key to configure it. \*\*T54W Line Key Icons are shown in Appendix. \*\*T41S Line Key Features are listed in Appendix.

#### SETUP VOICEMAIL CODE

- 1. Navigate to Menu->Message->Voice Mail->Set Voice Mail Code.
- 2. Enter the voice mail code (for example, \*4) in the desired account field.
- 3. Select Save.

#### LINSENTING TO VOICEMAIL

When a new voicemail is left, press the **Voicemail** key and type in the **voicemail pin** followed by "**#**" to listen to your voicemail.

\*\*The default voicemail pin will be provided in the welcome email by your phone system administrator.

#### CALL HISTORY

The Call History application is a stored log of your placed, received, missed, and forwarded calls. You can view, place a call, add to contact, and delete an entry from the call history list.

- 1. Press **History** soft key or navigate to **Menu-> History**.
- 2. Select the desired entry,
  - Select **Option->Detail** to view the entry.
  - Select Call to place a call.
  - Select Option->Add to Contact, then select Save to add the contact to local directory.
  - Select **Delete** to delete the entry.
